

## Hiking La Crosse Blufflands South— Hass Tract

aster Rd.

Enjoy a challenging out-and back hike with several options for loops and side trails. From the parking lot on Easter Road 1 to the bench at the end of the main trail 9 is approximately 1 mile.

How to get to the trailhead/parking lot from from the intersection of Losey Boulevard and Ward Avenue: Head east on Ward Ave to 33rd Street. Turn right on 33rd St and follow south to Park Lane Dr. Turn left and follow to Maple Dr. Turn right and go one block to Easter Rd. Turn left (at the fork in the road stay right) and follow to the trailhead, which is about .25 mile up the road and on the right.


- Start at Easter Road trailhead/parking lot. 43° 46.602' N, 91° 11.921'W
- **Cross creek on bridge.** 43° 46.550′ N, 91° 11.901′ W
- T-intersection; turn right. 43° 46.535' N, 91° 11.977' W
- Urrn left to take a side trail below and east of the ridge crest trail. 43° 46.639' N, 91° 12.095' W
- Sharp left to hike ridge crest trail. 43° 46.657' N, 91° 12.118'W
- Views of Mormon Coulee Rd, seminary, Shopko to west. 43° 46.505' N, 91° 12.056'W
- Side trails to east and west. 43° 46.361' N, 91° 11.863'W

- Bharp right turn onto wide mowed lane at gate to private road. 43° 46.361' N, 91° 11.863' W
- Bench near power lines at overlook. 43° 46.299' N, 91° 11.915'W
- From 9 turn east and walk toward power poles. Just past first power pole on right, turn right (south). 43° 46.326'N 91° 11.725'W
- Overlook. From this rocky outcrop on a goat prairie you can see Waterford Valley, Mt. La Crosse, and the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe. 43° 46.221'N 91° 11.678'W
